German label Glückskind Schallplatten announce their 17<sup>th</sup> vinyl release this Spring as label owners Jürgen Kirsch and Micha Klang prepare to celebrate the labels upcoming 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary. With 16 ep's under their belts and nine digital ep's having gained the label critical acclaim and praise for their no format label, they say they simply aim to "release good music with no agenda." Italian producer's Mirco Violi and Domy head up this five track offering with two remixes from Norman Weber and Marco Resmann, better known as the respected duo, Luna City Express.

*Woodstock*, the ep's A1 conjures percussive drums layered over a heady kick that's mingled with a haunting American vocal speech. Referencing "half a million young people can get together and have three days of fun and music, and nothing but fun and music, and I god bless you for it!", we can only assume a tribute to the 60's festival itself. A culmination of deliriously irresistible breaks and clever arrangements make *Woodstock* a dance floor must have. Luna City Express's remix on the flip punches the kick into 5<sup>th</sup> gear and a persistent and rapid bass line turn this already determined track into a relentless stomper. Exactly what every dark floor needs to push things up to the next level, cleverly balanced high's and seductive bass induce the perfect early morning dance floor feel.

The ep's a2 side, *Always*, takes us on another tech journey with a bass line that's riddled with funk and hat's that scream for attention. It's simple yet hypnotic edge boast a strong kick and hollow percussion patterns. Subdued and echoey vocals float over the heavy rhythm as the beat whirls menacingly through our cages.

*Shamu*, the ep's b2 is equally competing to its counterparts. The warm sequencing bass melts into the hypnotic chords and rich hat's, yet again forcing our minds and bodies into Mirco and Domy's dark yet flawless techno mind field. Glückskind Schallplatten have once again pulled out the stops with 'Woodstock'. An expertly produced and solid techno ep that comes with an extra bonus treat on the digital release in the form of the *Woodstock Deep Wood* remix from Luna City Express.
